

Covid-19 Vaccine - Mobile Health On The Move Van In Wokingham

A specially adapted vaccination van takes to the roads in Berkshire West week beginning 28th June as part of a drive to increase uptake of the Covid-19 jab.

Healthcare professionals and wellbeing teams will be on board the 'Health on the

Move' van ready to answer Covid questions and offer people the vaccination.

Anyone is welcome to visit the van, they don't need to be registered with a GP, although the health teams will be happy to help them sort that so in future they have access to a range of healthcare professionals at a local surgery.

The van's visits are being co-ordinated by Berkshire West Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) in partnership with local authority teams from Reading, Wokingham and West Berkshire. Opt-out of GP Patient Data Collection- Deadline extended

A project which allows patients to opt out of having details of their GP medical records shared for health research and planning has been extended, meaning patients now have until September to opt out.



WORRIED ABOUT HOUSING COSTS?

During the pandemic, there has been an eviction ban in place in England. This means landlords have not been allowed to send bailiffs to evict tenants and have had to give people six months warning of court action. However, the eviction ban was lifted on May 31st.

The rules are different in the other parts of the UK and may be subject to change. If this concerns you, read our <u>Emergency Help: I am worried about being evicted page</u> for more information on where to go for information and advice

If you are struggling with rent arrears or housing costs, there are a number of options

available to you;

- If you receive Housing Benefit or the housing element of Universal Credit, you may be eligible for a Discretionary Housing Payment at the discretion of your local authority.
- Use our free and easy-to-use Benefit Calculator to see what benefits you may be entitled to.
- Use our Grants Search to see if you are eligible for a grant (that doesn't have to be paid back) from a charitable fund, based on your background, circumstances and needs.
