Description of the location

The building is 2 storey, with disabled access and is situated in the rural village of Crowthorne. Access to the building is via a foyer and there is a light, easy to use wheelchair for those patients needing additional help. Car parking facilities are available to the front of the building. There are 5 consulting rooms, 2 treatment rooms, and an additional room for phlebotomy. All these rooms are located on the ground floor. There are also patient toilets (unisex and disabled) on the ground floor. On the second floor, there are administration rooms, staff toilet and a kitchen.

In addition to the 2 Partners, there is a salaried GP (Dr Susanne Buttner). Our nursing staff consists of two Nurse Practitioners, two nurses, one Assistant Practitioner and one phlebotomist.

Our administration team consists of a practice manager, operations manager, senior receptionist and 5 medical receptionists. The staff has also undergone chaperone training. In addition, we have two secretaries and one admin assistant. We have a Clinical Assistant and a Medical Records Officer.

We are a General Medical Services (GMS) Practice offering primary care services for the diagnosis and prevention of disease. We help patients manage their health and prevent illness. Our health professionals assess, diagnose, treat and manage illness. We carry out screening for some diseases and promote general health and wellbeing. Our health professionals act as a patient's advocate, supporting and representing a patient's best interests to ensure they receive the best and most appropriate health and/or social care. Our health professionals also provide the link to further health services and work closely with other healthcare colleagues. We may also arrange hospital admissions and referrals to other services and specialists and link with secondary and community services about patient care, taking advice and sharing information where needed. Our health professionals are also involved in Supporting research via Oxford University
